Subpart A (F3 Gold LLC, 2018.
U.S. Forest Service Plan of Operations
for F3 SC2019 Exploration
Project). The Project site is located
north of Silver City, Pennington
County, South Dakota in Sections
19, 30, 31, T2N R5E and Sections
13, 14, 24, 25, T2N R4E. This
Project includes diamond core
drilling sites, access road mainte-
nance (as needed), drill pad
clearing (as needed), and reclama-
tion activities. Two staging areas
would be used to store equipment
and tools. Main access from the
north would be from National
Forest System Road (NFSR) 261
(Jenny Gulch Road) via county
Highway 237 (Rochford Road). The
